From the AZ 101 – Exit 36 Pima Road / Princess Drive and proceed north on Pima to Thompson Peak Parkway. Turn right/east to second traffic light, then left on E. Desert Camp Drive to Guard Gate.

DC Ranch Dress Code for the Clubhouse

Proper “Country Club” attire is required at all times in the dining areas of the Clubhouse, **except** Monday through Saturday prior to 10 a.m., and 9 a.m. Sunday. “Proper” Country Club attire is at the discretion of Country Club Management.

“Proper” attire for gentlemen *of all ages, including children*, includes shirts with collars (including mock collars), which, if designed for and tailored appropriately, may be worn ‘untucked’, and dress sweaters. Golf shorts, dress shorts (mid-thigh or below) and dress denim are permissible. Proper “Country Club” attire for ladies of all ages, including children, includes dresses, skirts, slacks, mid-length shorts, tailored sleeveless shirts, blouses and golf/tennis clothing specifically designed and marketed as such unless specifically prohibited per the following:

Proper “Country Club” attire in the Clubhouse for either gender **does not** include t-shirts, spaghetti strap tank-tops, razorback tops, strapless tops, halter tops, mesh shirts, sweatpants, swimwear, short shorts/skirts, athletic shorts, yoga pants, or jeans with holes or tears in them. The Club has a small supply of shirts with collars to loan, first come, first served, for your guests who may arrive improperly dressed. Please ask Club Management for assistance.

Please note that after 10 a.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. Sunday, Gentlemen may not wear hats or visors inside of the Clubhouse with the exception of the Gentlemen’s Locker Room and the Gentlemen’s Grill. It is preferred that Ladies not wear golf hats or visors in the Clubhouse during the day with the exception of the Ladies Locker Room and, with the exception of ‘dress hats’. Hats may not be worn in the common dining areas of the main Clubhouse after 4:30 P.M. Exclusions may apply for special events. Please also note that hats worn anywhere on club facilities **must** be worn with the bill facing forward.

Golf

Gentlemen: “Proper” attire for gentlemen of all ages includes shirts with collars (including mock collars may *NOT* be worn ‘un-tucked’). Proper attire **does** include any clothing specifically designed and marketed as such. Proper attire on the golf course **does not** include t-shirts, tank tops, mesh shirts, jeans, sweatpants, swimwear, short-shorts, cargo shorts or athletic shorts at any time.

Ladies: Dresses, skirts, slacks, mid-length shorts, tailored sleeveless shirts and blouse are considered appropriate attire. Proper golf attire includes any clothing specifically designed and marketed as such. Proper attire on the golf course **does not** include halter tops, t-shirts, cut-offs, sweat pants, warm-up suits, jeans, swim wear, short shorts, tennis dresses or other athletic shorts.

Golf Shoes: Appropriate golf shoes are required for all golfers. Football, soccer or other large knobby spike shoes are not allowed. Tennis shoes or other soft sole shoes are subject to the approval of the golf professional on duty. Use of non-metal spikes of a type approved by the club is mandatory.

Guard Gate

Please make sure the member you are visiting has placed your name on our Guest List at the Gate.

If you are playing golf with a member, your name will already be on the Guest List.

Valet Parking and Clubs

The Guard Gate will direct you to the Club entry drive. When you arrive at the facility, proceed past the tennis courts and swimming pool areas and go directly to the Clubhouse and the Valet parking station on the circle drive.

Please allow the attendants to assist you with removing and labeling your clubs – advise them of the member you are playing with. In addition, please allow the attendants to park your automobile – self-parking sometimes is problematic for the team or you. Ask them to direct you to the Golf Shop or front entrance.

Tipping

We are a non-cash tipping Club. Club employees are not permitted to accept gratuities.

Cell Phone Policy

Cellular phones must be set on fully silent mode while at the Club and, with discretion and consideration to others, may be used for texting and checking messages. In areas where voice calls are allowed, volume of conversation should be moderated so as not to disturb others nearby.

Cellular phones for voice calls are allowed:

- **In Phone Booths**
- **In Fire Pit Area and Event Lawn**

- **In Parking Lots**
- **In the Locker Rooms (except card playing areas with tables)**
- **In the Courtyard, unless there is a function**

Cellular phones for voice calls are expressly disallowed:

- **In the Pool Area**
- **In the Clubhouse and Grills**
- **On the Driving Range and Practice Area**
- **In the Golf Shop**
- **In the Tennis Shop**
- **In the Fitness Room**

Children

The Country Club at DC Ranch is a Family Friendly Club. We do ask that all children are properly dressed when coming to The Clubhouse or playing Golf. Club etiquette and behavior are expected of all children while at the Country Club. Insuring proper behavior is the responsibility of the parent or responsible adult member. Children 14 years of age and under, while on Club property must be accompanied and directly supervised by a Member or a designated supervisor at least 18 years of age.

Locker Room

The Country Club at DC Ranch has two full service locker rooms for changing clothing and shoes as necessary before and after play. If you do not wear your shoes to the course, please change only in the locker room.

Dining Rooms

The Country Club at DC Ranch has one main dining room. Please check-in with the hostess when you arrive prior to dining.

Golf Shop

The Club shop has a full array of clothing, balls, and other related items for sale and they do accept charge cards. Please note that tees, ball markers, towels, water bottles and an array of non-alcoholic beverages are supplied for you on the course.

Pace of Play

All players shall maintain a reasonable pace of play. Club Management encourages a pace of play by its Members so that under normal circumstances, an 18-hole round of golf may be completed in four hours or less, including any time stopping between nines. If a group fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one hole on the players in front, it shall either allow the group following to play through or pick up and proceed to the next tee.
